



**Cirrelda June (French) King Bayer**  
**1925 - 2016**

Cirrelda June (French) King Bayer, 90 yrs, died Friday, April 29, 2016. Friends may call at the Capaul Funeral Home, Ida, Tuesday, May 3, 2016, from 11 AM -9 PM. Cirrelda was born June 14, 1925, in Monroe, Michigan and was the daughter of Wesley and Irma (Loose) French of Monroe. She grew up on 6th Street in Monroe and graduated from Monroe High School in 1943. Cirrelda was particularly active in the school orchestra where she loved playing the violin. Following graduation, she was employed at the River Raisin Paper Company accounting department in Monroe until her marriage. On September 7, 1947, she married Jason D. King in the First Evangelical United Brethren Church, now known as the First United Methodist Church in Monroe, Michigan. Together they had four children. Jason died July 5, 1975. Four years later, Cirrelda married Glenn E. Bayer on August 18, 1979, in Grace United Methodist Church in Britton, Michigan. Cirrelda was a lifetime member of the First United Methodist Church and a choir member for many years. She was also a board member in the church and an active member of the prayer group where she made many lap quilts for the local nursing homes. She was also a member of Dundee Senior Center Board and an active participant in the Dundee Senior Fun Band for 19 years. She also participated in the Retired Senior Volunteer Program. In her earlier years, Cirrelda was a member of the Monroe County Historical Society, and she was also a member of the Centennial Farm Owners of Michigan. Cirrelda enjoyed being a homemaker all of her life. She had many interests and hobbies including music. She loved the violin and actively played piano as often as possible. She loved to bake and sew. She also loved antiques and going to local auctions. She particularly loved being with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Cirrelda is survived by her four children: Kathleen (Terry) Zibbell, Douglas (Sharon) King, Marilyn Rohrback and Holly (Joel) Fiedler. She has 10 grandchildren: Kerri (Christopher) Blackwell, Bryan (Nicole) Zibbell, Jason (Kim) Zibbell; Ryan King and Jason (Jessica) King; Shannon (Joo) Lee, Greg (Patly) Rohrback, Jacob (Soula) Rohrback; Josh Fiedler and Rachel Fiedler. She has 15 great-grandchildren. Cirrelda also has five step-children: Diana Bayer, Gaylord Bayer, Jonathon Bayer, Daniel Bayer and Steve Kreps.
